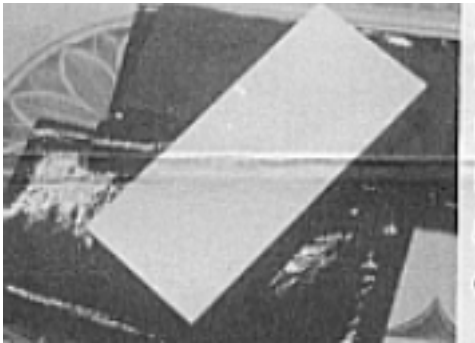


Wayne Barton Premier Chip Carving Knives.

These American made knives are the result of Wayne Barton's many years' experience in the field of chip carving. The blades are made from a high carbon steel for strength, durability, and to hold a razor edge longer. The cutting knife has an increased downward angle to the cutting edge to make carving natural and effortless. The tip is less blunt making it easy to remove wood from tight places. The stab knife has a longer cutting edge to add to the design possibilities. The handles are ergonomically shaped to fit the carver's hand, providing superior control of the blade and reducing hand fatigue. The larger slightly rounded configuration is extremely comfortable to hold, yet retains enough rectangular shape to provide the orientation that is so essential to maintaining the proper angle to the work.

Ceramic Sharpening Stones by Wayne Barton

These stones take the mystery out of sharpening. No messy oil or water is required. They are ideal for all sharpening applications and essential for chip carving where an extremely sharp edge is vital. The set includes two stones: medium grit grey and ultra fine white. Protective Pouch for Chip Carving Knives

Just the right answer for protecting the delicate edges of your knives (and the delicate skin of your fingers). The pouch has two compartments, one for the cutting knife and one for the stab knife and so will accommodate both of the Barton Premier Knives. They have a generous flap with attached tie to secure the knives in the pockets. They are made from a heavy reinforced vinyl material. This is the same stuff they use to make pickup truck bed covers.

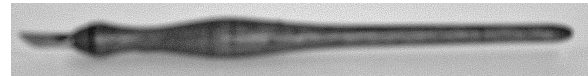

Kolrosing - A brief explanation.

Kolrosing (coal-rose-ing) is the Scandinavian art form of creating fine line decoration on wood. The design is cut into the wood with a special knife. Once the pattern is complete, dry coffee is rubbed into the cuts. The results are striking. This art form can be easily combined with chip carving to produce some outstanding creations. The knife and DVD listed below are all you need (along with some very finely ground coffee) to get started.



Kolrosing Knife. This is the knife featured in the Kolrosing DVD and the only tool you will need. Knife comes honed and ready to use. Occasional touchup on a strop is all the maintenance that is required.
